MINUTES

Vikki Martin began the meeting at 6:50 pm by thanking Ava Skipworth, owner of Monster Yogurt, for providing free yogurt for tonight and for making us their Coffee Charity Partner for September.

Martin announced FRI's new slogan: Mission: *Engage and empower a community of advocates to advance a safe, beautiful, prosperous and proud community.* Vision: *Far East Dallas is a strong and vital community.* Values: *Community, Integrity, Leadership, Respect, and Stewardship.*

Action Item: A motion to approve the minutes from February 19, 2018 and to approve tonight's minutes was made by Dan Ortman and seconded by Daniel Clayton. The motion passed.

ELECTED OFFICIALS AND FRIENDS OF FRI MADE ANNOUNCEMENTS

County Commissioner **Theresa Daniel** spoke on planning and design of trails around White Rock Lake. They are looking at connectivity of hike and bike trails with adjacent cities.

City Councilmember **Kevin Felder** said he is here to support the community regarding streets, code enforcement, and bond-funded projects. He announced a meeting on September 18 regarding Walmart's request for extending a Specific Use Permit for alcohol sales.

New Bayles School Principal **Gloria Patrick Kennedy** said she wants to be a vital part of the community. She asked for volunteers to help with their garden, etc. People can go to DISD web site for more information on volunteering.

Ann Bagley, Friends of the White Rock Hills Library, spoke on FRI's importance in implementing the White Rock Hills Library.

NORTH TEXAS GIVING DAY

Celeste Glover, Communities Foundation of Texas (Philanthropy Officer), said this is the largest giving event in the nation. A video presentation regarding NTGD and FRI was shown.

DALLAS POLICE DEPARTMENT

Sgt. Vickie Stonaker (<u>vickie.stonaker@dpd.ci.dallas.tx.us</u>) spoke on Volunteers in Patrol program. She can be reached at 214-670-4767. There will be a Kids' Health and Safety Fair for special needs children on November 10. They are having a coat drive, especially need large and extra large coats.

Desi Tanner, Truett Area Crime Watch, said they will start quarterly meetings in January and all CW and VIP organizations in the FRI community are invited. He spoke about their September 6 meeting on dealing with active shooters.

WHITE ROCK HILLS PARK

Matt Nicolette described the park's features and facilities. Groundbreaking for the park will be on Saturday, December 1, at 10 am at 2229 Highland Road at Ferguson Road.

GROVE AT WHITE ROCK HILLS

Rob Baldwin spoke on the proposed Weekley Homes project on Highland Road. Weekley is seeking Planned Development zoning for 35 single-family homes, 1600+ sq. ft. each. They expect to go to the Planning Commission around October 4 and, if successful, start construction in January/February 2019, with completion in early summer. ANIMAL WELFARE

Nilso Portillo, Dallas Spay Neuter Network Services, spoke on their goal to eliminate pet overpopulation thru subsidized spay bank services.

Senester King, Dallas Animal Services, said they are looking for loose animals that are aggressive, especially wants to take care of these situations quickly. Call 9-1-1 to report loose animals, get a Service Request Number for follow-up. Take photos of pet violations and send to Animal Services.

Stephanie Timko, City of Dallas Animal Advisory Commission representative for District 7, spoke about the role of the City Animal Advisory Commission.

OWENWOOD FARM AND NEIGHBOR SPACE

Rev. Mitchell Boone and Neil Moseley spoke on the progress being made at Owenwood Farm and Neighbor Space (OFNS). They report that services are already being provided through their diaper distribution program and White Rock Community Church is holding services there. They are now working with GrowNorthTexas on an urban farm on their property. They are working to develop new relationships in the area, want to provide after-school programs for students at SS Connor Elementary and programs for area seniors. Neil Moseley

spoke on receiving two grants totaling for \$130,000 for governance planning and capital improvements to the building. There will be a polling place in November. They have a theater group coming in October, will present "Little Women" in November and an adaptation of "The Nutcracker Suite" in December (mention FRI and you can get in free.).

DETERMINATION INC

Since seniors want to stay in their homes longer, Determination Inc is working to identify senior service needs for our area through a survey process.

20 SEASONS OF LOVE APPRECIATION BREAKFAST

Susan Hopper, chairperson for the event, spoke on celebrating FRI's 20 years of community involvement, to be held at OFNS on November 10, 9-11 a.m. A complimentary breakfast will be provided to all FRI members. Mayor Rawlings plans to attend, the keynote speaker is Phil Ritter (CEO, Meadows Mental Health Policy Institute), and Bishop Michael McKee will also attend. There will be performances by One Loud Suitcase, The Episcopal School of Dallas Concert Choir, and a special video presented. DISD TAX RATIFICATION ELECTION

Dan Micchiche, DISD Board of Trustees, spoke on DISD being the most improved ISD in Texas. He spoke on the progress of DISD and the benefits that would come to the district if the TRE passes. He spoke on 51 schools that now have Dual Language programs and the success of the school turnaround program. 5th graders at Blanton School outperformed Highland Park students, showing how DISD has improved.

The new DISD tax rate (TRE) is needed because state funding is low. 13 of14 Collin County ISD's passed tax increases. Businesses will pay 60% of any tax increase. A \$185,000 house would pay an additional \$20/month. If one is over 65, they will pay no additional tax. There are 4 propositions regarding DISD on the November ballot. He urged the community to support Propositions A, B, C, D.

The meeting was adjourned.
