#### **DPD Officer Theron Aiken**

White Rock Hills: 34% White Rock East: 23%

**Daniel Wood, Park Board Vice President**, spoke on Lakeland Hills Park regarding park utilization, new exercise equipment, tree planting, lighting improvements, tennis courts, parking lot, dog park and upgrading the skate park. The soccer fields are to remain as-is. The Park Board is to meet February 27 on park improvements. FRI will submit a request for \$24M in the 2024 bond election for a recreation/community center.
