3. Deploy officers effectively






Send up to 5 photos regardless of resolution.



Make an audio recording to describe complex or dynamic situations



Send camera videos to police, or upload from your doorbell or home security cameras.



Send accurate gps coordinates to police in a tip or in chat. GPS can be disabled.



Police can send informational & emergency alerts to users with the location of incident.

Spanish-speaking users will see all app features and functions in their native language.



Describing Behavior


